The 2018-2020, 15-month, Master of Science in Nursing program is 33 continuous semester hours from summer of 2018 to spring of 2020, with a **total tuition cost of \$34,650** at \$1,050 per credit hour.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.

Total tuition cost: \$34,650

Prospective students should be aware that adding additional credit hours by adding a track outside the C&O Generalist area will result in an increase in total tuition and program costs.
