## Program Cost Sheet MSN (BSN-MSN & RN-B-MSN) Care and Outcomes



The 2021-2022, 15-month, Master of Science in Nursing program is 33 continuous semester hours from summer of 2021 to Summer of 2022, with a **total tuition cost of \$35,706** at \$1,082 per credit hour.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), books and materials for coursework.

**Total Tuition Cost: \$35,706** 

Nursing Program Fees: \$3,795 (Subject to change)

Prospective students should be aware that adding additional credit hours by adding a track outside the C&O Generalist area will result in an increase in total tuition and program costs.
