DRAMATURGICAL NOTES

In this retelling of *Orpheus and Euridyce*, Jasper finds himself meeting all of the mythological figures we know and love...or, slightly enjoy. Pluto (more commonly known as Hades), Lord of the Underworld, is Zeus's brother, who reigns over all of the undead. He's a charismatic businessman, quick to make deals with any willing creature. Persephone, Queen of the Underworld, is also the Goddess of Spring as well as daughter of Demeter and Zeus. While she resides in the Underworld for her contracted amount of time, she is indifferent to her husband and is definitely more kind-hearted than he is. Other mythological figures include Ammut, Hel, and Loki - all from different cultures of myth - making for an exceptionally twisted story.

While Jasper meets dangerous folk and explores the watery depths of the Underworld, the hardest opponents he faces may be his own inner demons.
