- Woodwind and Brass players may be asked to play a 2-octave scale in addition to their selection and the sight-reading material, plus instrument-specific requirements listed online.

- \*All percussionists on a music scholarship must audition on Saturday at 5:40 pm if they want to also audition for the Jazz Ensemble. It is also highly recommended for non-scholarship percussionists.
