# **About the Conductors**

Ron Gerhardstein is Associate Professor of Music Education and Associate Director of Bands at PLU. In addition to directing the University Concert Band, he teaches coursework related to music education, instrumental methods, and the supervision of student teachers. Prior to his appointment at PLU in 2014, he taught for thirteen years in the West Valley School District in Yakima, WA. Recent guest conducting appearances include the WMEA Jr. All-State "Rainier" Band (2017), the South West Washington Small Schools Honor Band (2018), the Lake Washington School District Honor Band (2018), and the Asia-Pacific (APAC) Honor Band in Kobe, Japan (2019). Dr. Gerhardstein holds degrees from the University of Idaho and Temple University. Dr. Gerhardstein is currently serving as the President of the Washington Music Education Association (WMEA). He lives in Tacoma with his wife Jerilyn, a teacher-librarian in the Bethel School District.

Edwin Powell is the Director of Bands and Professor of Music at Pacific Lutheran University, where he is responsible for the University Wind Ensemble, conducting and music education methods courses. In 2015 he was the recipient of a Pacific Lutheran University Faculty Excellence Award. Dr. Powell earned degrees from the University of the Pacific, the Cincinnati College – Conservatory of Music, and The University of North Texas, where he completed a Doctor of Musical Arts in Conducting, studying with Eugene Migliaro Corporon. Previous to his 2005 appointment at PLU, Dr. Powell was on faculty at the University of Tennessee, where he was Assistant Director of Bands responsible for the Symphonic Band, the 350-member Pride of the Southland Marching Band, conducting courses and music education methods courses. Dr. Powell maintains an active schedule as a clinician and adjudicator worldwide conducting groups from San Francisco, California to Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. He enjoys producing recordings, is a contributing author for the immensely popular textbook series *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band*, by GIA Publications, and is published in the *NBA Journal*, *Voice Magazine* and the *Journal of Band Research*.

#### **About the Student Conductors**

Robin Wessel is a senior from Auburn, WA, majoring in music education. Throughout her time at PLU, Robin has been a member of the Wind Ensemble, Sølvvinden Flute Ensemble, Concert Band, Symphony Orchestra, jazz combos, and University Singers choir. She has performed in Hawaii for the 2019 PLU Wind Ensemble Tour, and various pit and orchestra gigs around the Tacoma area. Robin is currently in the UW Husky Marching Band and is doing pre-student teaching at North Thurston High School in Lacey, where she will also complete her full-time student teaching in the Spring. After graduating this Spring, she desires to teach band at the middle or high school level in Washington for three to five years before pursuing her Master's in wind conducting.

**Kaelyn Marie Morgan** is a fourth-year music education major with a focus in secondary instrumental music. She has been playing the saxophone for eight years, and plays tenor saxophone in both the PLU Wind Ensemble and the University Jazz Ensemble. She currently runs her lesson studio through Ted Brown Music, teaching the single-reed woodwind instruments to students of all ages. While studying conducting under Dr. Edwin Powell and the Girls Who Conduct Mentorship Program, she found a great love for orchestral and wind ensemble conducting, and plans to move on to a graduate level conducting program after gaining some experience in the classroom and on the podium, with the ultimate goal of conducting professional ensembles. In this iteration of Steven Bryant's *Dusk*, she hopes to create a highly unique and emotional experience for the audience, emphasizing the vivid colors that each instrument's timbre brings to the music, and highlighting the aspects of the piece that make it truly sound like dusk.
