The Bachelor of Science in Music Therapy at Pacific Lutheran University prepares students for national board certification (MT-BC) through a rigorous and integrated course of study. Students build a strong understanding of psychology, neuroscience, and healthcare practice, developing the analytical and interpersonal skills essential for effective, evidence-based clinical work.
