### General Degree Requirements

- A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.00 or higher.
- Students must complete all other requirements of the University as listed in the catalog, in addition to the requirements of this major.
- At least 8 semester hours for the major must be taken in residence at PLU.

### ANTHROPOLOGY MAJOR - Bachelor of Arts Degree

- Requires 36 semester hours.
- To register for any ANTH course with pre-requisite, a grade of C- or better must be attained in each of the prerequisite courses.
- To remain in the anthropology major, students must maintain a minimum 2.50 overall GPA and maintain a minimum 2.50 GPA in all of their anthropology courses taken at PLU.
- The BA in Anthropology requires completion of the College of Arts Science Language requirement.
- No more than 44 hours from ANTH may be counted towards the 128 semester hours required for graduation. If a student takes more than 44 hours in ANTH (via transfer or at PLU), he/she must earn additional hours above the 128 in order to earn the degree.
