Please note: Nursing students enroll in classes according to their cohort. There are Fall and Spring starts. You MUST be admitted to the School of Nursing in order to enroll in any Nursing courses. The School of Nursing application is separate and in addition to the general PLU admissions application.

All course offerings depend on such things as the university budget, instructor availability, and enrollment.
