<b>**BUSA Elective:</b>				
Hours must be upper-division electives in purposeful selection. Proposals must be made in advance and not later than second semester of the junior year. Proposal to include statement of objectives, rationale, program of study, and endorsement of a business faculty sponsor. Requires approval of the dean or his/her designate. Only 4 semester hours of independent study, if approved, may apply to the concentration. Variations on existing concentrations are not acceptable.

### **Business Degree Requirements**

- An overall minimum grade point average of 2.50
- A minimum 2.50 grade point average separately in business courses
- C- minimum grade in all business and supplemental foundation courses
- At least 55 semester hours business, including 16 semester hours of business electives

### **General Degree Requirements**

- A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.50 or higher
- In addition to the requirements of this major, students must complete all other requirements of the University as listed in the catalog
- At least 28 semester hours for the major must be taken in residence at PLU.
