## Education Major Requirements

- Requires 69 hours in coursework
- All individuals seeking to enter an undergraduate degree program must apply to the department. A completed application must be submitted to the department by the application deadline published on their website (typically early February) for Fall Semester admission.
- 2.5 overall GPA is required to graduate from the major.
- All coursework designated by EDUC, SPED, or EPSY have been completed with a B- grade or better.

## General Degree Requirements

- A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.00 or higher
