- Students choose at least one course from category (1): ENGL 301, 351, 360, 370, 380, 386, 393, 399, OR ENGL 311/PPAP 301/COMA 321
- Students choose at least one course from category (2): ENGL 334, 348, 394, 395, 396, 397, OR 398

to take enough courses (shown here as electives) to reach the 128 credits needed to graduate.

## Department Requirements

- At least 36 and up to 44 semester hours in English (excluding WRIT 101) with at least 20 hours upper division
- Required for all English majors. ENGL 300 must be taken before, and not concurrently with, ENGL 400 and Senior Capstone (ENGL 451/452). The department recommends that students take ENGL 300 in their sophomore or junior year.


## General Degree Requirements

- A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.00 or higher
- In addition to the requirements of this major, students must complete all other requirements of the University as listed in the CATALOG
- At least 8 semester hours for the major must be taken in residence at PLU.
