General education course requirements are listed assuming that major classes will not count toward the general education course requirements. If a course counts towards a major and a general education requirement (e.g. PSYC 101 if the student is a psychology major), students will still need to take enough courses (shown here as electives) to reach the 128 credits needed to graduate.

Kinesiology Major Requirements

- 86 Semester Hours
- At least 32 credits of all majors must be taken in residency at PLU, and at least 16 of those must be taken from within the Department of Kinesiology.
- At least eight semester hours applied toward a kinesiology minor must be earned independently from the kinesiology major requirements.
- Students must have a 2.75 to be eligible to apply for the School of Education and Kinesiology.
- Valid First Aid Card

General Degree Requirements

- A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.00 or higher students must have a 2.75 to be eligible to apply for the School of Education and Kinesiology. At least 40 credits must be upper division coursework.
- In addition to the requirements of this major, students must complete all other requirements of the University as listed in the catalog
- At least 8 semester hours for the major must be taken in residence at PLU.— students would need to take more than 8 semester hours in residence for their teaching certificate.
