Guest Speaker - Elisabeth Ward, Director, Scandinavian Cultural Center

- The session began with a summary of who each person in ASC represents, as well as Elisabeth's background.
- History of the Scandinavian Cultural Center (SCC)
 - PLU has a long Scandinavian/Nordic presence on campus.
 - 1970s a Scandinavian Area Studies program was started.
 - Auden Toven was instrumental in working towards the creation of the SCC.
 - 1983-1985 consisted of a concentrated effort to raise funds for the SCC and in 1989 the SCC was dedicated. (The remainder of the basement of the AUC was finished due directly to the SCC.)
- Current Events in the SCC
 - Annual Events:
 - Sankta Lucia Festival
 - Norwegian Heritage Festival
 - Swedish Heritage Festival
 - Nordic Film Series
 - Norwegian Language Christmas Service
 - Monthly Events:
 - Danish Sangeaften
 - Norwegian Cooking Classes (\$5)
 - Swedish Cooking Classes (\$5)
 - Lectures
 - Folkart Classes
- Constituents consist of:
 - Members of the community with Scandinavian heritage.
 - PLU Alumni
 - Scandinavian Students
 - Students in Scandinavian Studies programs
 - There are about 300 members with 20 that serve on the council.
 - \circ There is one full time person (Elisabeth) and several student workers.
- Resources
 - The SCC has about 3000 artifacts.
 - Almost all have been donated by members.
 - The sale of a select few of these items has helped in adding to the operating budget and endowments.
- Upcoming Changes
 - Elisabeth is looking to change some of the exhibits, getting more student involvement, as well as remodeling the SCC. She would also like to create a closer integration with many of the PLU communities.
- Membership
 - The cost of membership is \$25 (individual) and \$35 (family) annually. The SCC is free to the PLU community.
- During the question and answer period, it was discussed that Elisabeth is focusing on using Facebook and will be working on Twitter feeds as well. It was suggested that events be added to the KPLU calendar and may be mentioned on air, as well.
