

- The 2017-2018, 18-month Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate is 33 continuous semester hours from summer of 2017 to Fall of 2018, with a total program cost of \$36,795 or \$1,115 per semester hour.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
