

Program Cost Sheet

Post-Graduate Certificate for Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner



- The 2017-2019, 24-month Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner Certificate is 41 continuous semester hours from summer of 2017 to spring of 2019, with a total program cost of \$45,715 or \$1,115 per semester hour.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing. Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
- Federal financial aid is available, and students may apply for PLU Graduate scholarship and fellowships. The FAFSA application becomes available for the following academic year on January 1st.
