

# Program Cost Sheet

## Post-Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioner



The Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate is 40 semester credits with a **total tuition cost of \$45,000** or \$1,125 per semester hour.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.

Nursing Program Fee: \$4,266 (Subject to change)

### Total Tuition: \$45,000

The actual start term for individual students and required coursework will be determined based on gap analysis of previous coursework (must meet the AACN DNP Essentials competencies).
