

Program Cost Sheet

Post-Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioner



The Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate is 40 semester credits with a **total tuition cost of \$45,920** or \$1,148 per semester hour.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), books and materials for coursework.

Total Tuition: \$45,920

Nursing Program Fee: \$1,320 (*Subject to change*)

The actual start term for individual students and required coursework will be determined based on gap analysis of previous coursework (must meet the AACN DNP Essentials competencies).
