

# Program Cost Sheet AY2022

## Post-Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioner



This Family Nurse Practitioner Post-Graduate Certificate requires 40 semester credits with a **total tuition cost of \$46,360**.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

**Total Tuition: \$46,360** (\$1,159 per semester credit)

**Nursing Program Fee: \$3,346** (*Subject to change*)

**Additional fees include:** technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), background check (\$70), books and materials for coursework, uniform cost (\$200), equipment (\$100), laptop (not Chromebook).

The actual start term for individual students and required coursework will be determined based on gap analysis of previous coursework (must meet the AACN DNP Essentials competencies).
