

## **Introduction to Perspectives on Diversity in the Core Documents**

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When the faculty assembly adopted the present version of the core curriculum, enacting the Perspectives on Diversity requirement, the Committee for Perspectives on Diversity in the Core was established. The committee was charged with bringing guidelines for courses that would fulfill the requirement to the faculty assembly for approval and with acting in an advisory capacity to EPC in the approval of such courses.

The first document below, “Fulfilling Diversity Lines in the Core Curriculum: Course Guidelines,” is the set of guidelines adopted by the faculty assembly on December 10, 1994.

The second document, “Perspectives on Diversity in the Core Checklist,” was created by the Committee for Perspectives on Diversity in the Core and is based on the Faculty approved guidelines. It was one of the efforts of the committee to help faculty successfully design courses for the requirement.

The ad hoc Committee for Perspectives on Diversity in the Core “sunsetting” and EPC now solicits advice as needed from members of the faculty with the appropriate expertise. These documents are published here to facilitate faculty efforts to diversify the curriculum.
