- Psychology faculty will judge the papers. They will read the papers with authors' names removed.

 - ♦ What was your role in the research project?
 - ♦ How was the research conceived?
 - ♦ What do you think are its major contributions (basic and applied)?
 - ♦ What have you learned from the experience?
