- ◆ is open to any student who has completed 16 credits in psychology.
- ◆ The research must be original and, in an area, related to psychology.
- ◆ Joint authorship is allowed. Joint authorship with a faculty member is acceptable if the student is the primary author. APA journal article format is required. If you want assistance in writing in APA format, please see the **Publication manual for the American Psychological Association**.
- ◆ Psychology faculty will judge the papers. They will read the papers with authors' names removed.
- ◆ **Project Description:** In the section labeled "Project Description," please answer the following questions about your research project:
  - ◆ What was your role in the research project?
  - ◆ How was the research conceived?
  - ◆ What do you think are its major contributions (basic and applied)?
  - ◆ What have you learned from the experience?
- ◆ Deadline for submission is **Monday, April 28th by 5:00pm**. The following items should be emailed in to **Christine Nicolai (nicolacs@plu.edu)** using the subject line, "Research Award Application 2025."
  - ◆ An electronic copy of this completed application form with answers to the above questions,
  - ◆ An electronic copy of the paper—saved as a Word document with all authors' names removed—
- ◆ **The Research Award will be presented** during the program following the Psychology Student Research Conference **Thursday, May 15th**.
