We are writing to formally invite you to become involved with Winterfest 2018! Winterfest is a Parkland-Spanaway community event that inspires hope by connecting low-income families with gifts and resources during the holiday season. Winterfest has been a staple in the Parkland-Spanaway community for the last 28 years and will be held at **Rainier View Christian Church on Saturday, December 8th, 2018 from 9am-12pm.**

We hope that you will consider partnering with us to continue the tremendous momentum of Winterfest 2017 by helping us to achieve our primary goals:

- Provide quality Christmas gifts to students in the Franklin Pierce Schools who might otherwise go without
- Empower families to access local opportunities and resources that lead to self sufficiency
- Build community in Parkland-Spanaway by connecting leaders, organizations, residents and families across barriers that typically divide

Last year at Winterfest, we recruited **340 volunteers** ranging in age from 9 to 90. These dedicated volunteers served **340 families** and approximately **1090 local children!** Winterfest costs approximately **\$32,000** to operate and maintain each year. We rely on local businesses and civic groups to invest in Winterfest.

This upcoming year, we hope to increase our capacity to serve more local families. Unfortunately, this past year we had to turn families away from Winterfest as we did not have the financial means to support them. With your support, we are confident that we can reach our goal of serving **1,200 local children.**
