

Dear Parkland Spanaway Community Partner-

During July and August, we often forget the immense pressure that families in our community feel during the cold winter months, especially around the holidays. We hope that you might consider partnering with us to offer Winterfest 2019, a Parkland Spanaway community event that inspires hope by connecting low-income families with gifts and resources during the holiday season. This year's event will take place on Saturday, December 14 at Rainier View Christian Church.

In its 29th year, Winterfest has a proven track record of supporting close to 300 families annually, providing coats, toys and hygiene items to nearly 1,000 kids. The event consists of a fun holiday carnival for children, while their parents and guardians shop and meet with local resource providers that offer services ranging from financial empowerment and adult education to healthcare and transportation.

While the numbers are impressive, it is the spirit of collaboration that links leaders and businesses across the Parkland Spanaway community that makes Winterfest remarkable. From the Franklin Pierce Schools counselors who identify the neediest families, the 300+ volunteers that welcome, support and manage the event to the 35 local businesses that serve as donation sites, and 12 financial sponsors that invest thousands of dollars each year, Winterfest represents the best of what can happen when our community bands together to care for one another. The sense of relief, excitement and appreciation from families that attend Winterfest serves as a reminder that the holidays can represent a time of anxiety for many families in our community.

We rely on investment from churches, businesses, local organizations, civic groups and generous neighbors to fund the nearly \$40,000 required to host Winterfest each year. While the vast majority of these donations come in the form of in-kind gifts, financial contributions allow event leaders to leverage purchasing power and plan ahead.
