What does it mean to have a dream?

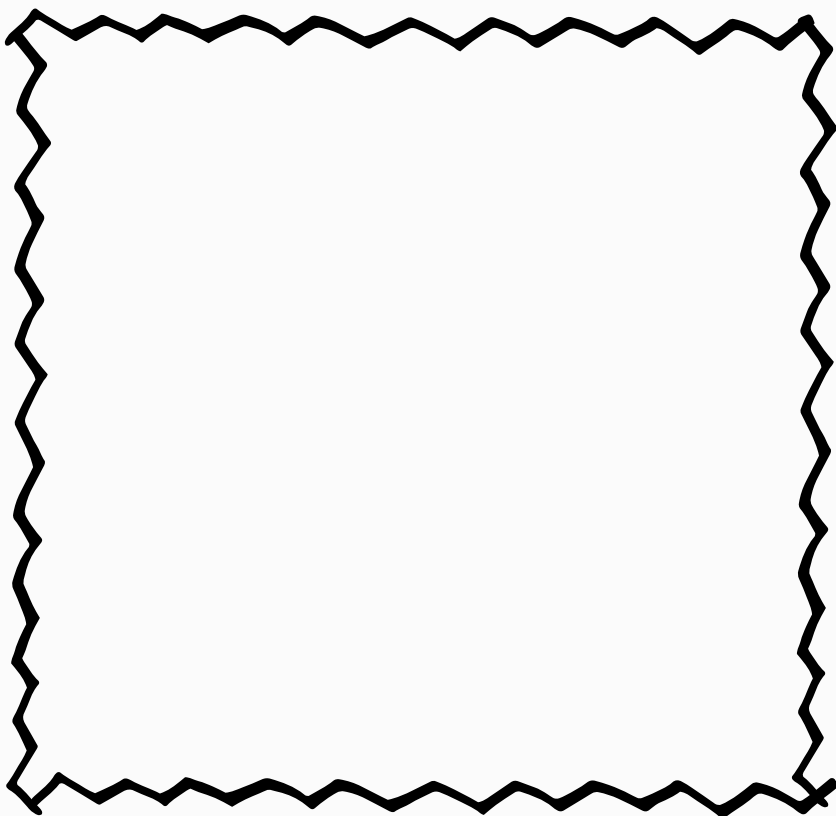
