The award will be sent to the recipient's college for next fall semester unless the recipient requests the funds for summer school.

- 1. Complete the attached application form either by email or regular mail post-dated by May 4, 2022.
- 2. Obtain two letters of recommendations from persons who can speak with authority about you. These can be included with your application or mailed separately by the above date.
 - One letter should come from a teacher at your past high school or a current teacher/professor where you are attending currently. This letter should address your abilities, leadership, personality, and future promise.
 - b. The second letter should come from a person of your choice who is NOT a relative. It should be non-academic I nature. For example, it can be from a coach, a neighbor, your clergy a work supervisor or another outside interest. This letter should cover notable skills, leadership or other qualities, awards, or experiences of which said person is aware.
 - c. Obtain a copy of your official college transcript and include it with your application materials.
 - d. Attach a copy of your driver's license or voter registration card to prove Washington residency.
