PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Social determinants of health will be explored based on the history and current culture of indigenous populations. Explorations include engaging in activities at/with significant archaeological sites, traditional healers including herbalists, and local artisans to better understand associated risks and benefits of living in the communities as it relates to healthcare access. Additionally, students will provide basic health screenings and education in multiple communities throughout the region including at schools, healthcare facilities, and orphanages. Note: training will be provided. A public health perspective will be taken with each outing as we are collecting information regarding social determinants of health. Students in public health, social work, pre-med, nursing, and other health-care related fields are particularly encouraged to apply for this program.
