COURSE OVERVIEW

Pacific Lutheran University in partnership with Sichuan University in Chengdu, China offers a two-week study tour in Chengdu.

The program includes:

- Chinese language and Chinese culture classes
- Field trips to explore local culture
- Engagement with Chinese and other international students participating in Sichuan University International Immersion Program
- One Pacific Lutheran University credit for participating students

Sichuan University, PLU's Chinese partner in China, will provide a scholarship to each participating student to cover domestic travel in China from and to the port of entry, language class tuition, cultural travel cost, room & board, and health coverage during the two-week program. The PLU program fee covers airfare to and from China and the cost of a Chinese visa.
