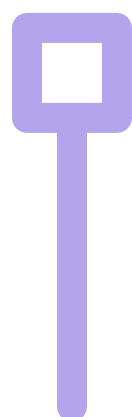

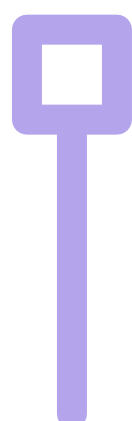
A GUIDE TO YOUR UNIVERSITY RESPONSE OPTIONS

1. IF YOU CHOOSE NOT TO FILE A FORMAL COMPLAINT



- Meet with the Title IX Coordinator and Receive Supportive Measures
 - (No Contact Order, Housing Relocation, etc.)

OPTION A



- Choose if you would like to take further action or not. If not, the process stops here



If you choose to take further action, but not enter the Formal Process:

- Request an Educational Meeting be conducted with the other party

OPTION B

2. IF YOU CHOOSE TO FILE A FORMAL COMPLAINT



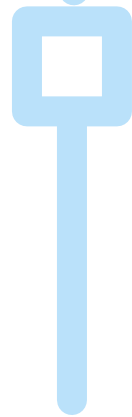
- Request an Informal Resolution
- Both Parties Must Agree
- Meet with a Mediator to Devise a Resolution

OPTION A



- University Begins Formal Process
- Investigation Takes Place
- Evidence is Gathered/Witness(es) Interviewed
- Formal Hearing Conducted

OPTION B



Depending on Jurisdiction:

- Code of Conduct = Review Meeting (SRR)
- Title IX Hearing = Advisors and Cross Examination (Title IX)

Decision is Rendered and Sanctions are Applied to those Found Responsible
Corrective Measures Implemented
