Membership is open all employees (faculty and staff) of Pacific Lutheran University.

Regular members and those honorary members who choose to pay dues hold the rights to vote at USA meetings and to be elected to the Board of Directors. All members may participate in USA programs and activities, use USA facilities, bring guests to USA functions, and have a voice in USA meetings.

\$180.00 per year in dues provides 9 months of membership benefits (September through May). While there are no USA events, lunchtime talks, or other functions during the summer months, use of USA facilities is still permitted.

*For part-time employees (anything less than 1.0 full-time), there is a discounted membership for \$90 per year.
